CHURCH NEWS

Straight Road Baptist Church is open for business! Mr. Samnang and his wife continue to be extremely helpful in our ministry. Whether on her job as a public-school teacher or in the church, she sees the children through spiritual eyes. He drives our church vehicle, operates the computer and projector, and is my soul-winning partner. Please pray for him, as he is suffering with diabetes.

Lately more than ever, I have been challenging our church members in the area of soul winning. Recently, we were so happy to hear the testimony of one lady, who is married to the "drinking man" referred to in previous letters. She goes to the hospital quite regularly for certain ailments, and she always shares Christ with her fellow patients.

DISCIPLESHIP NEWS

About five weeks ago, my wife started a short discipleship class for the teens just before the evening Sunday service. This enables her to give some teaching more tailored to their needs and interests. Several of our youth have described personal problems or family issues that need a loving and Biblical touch, and this is a good start.

About six weeks ago, we also started a Bible Club near our house that meets every Saturday evening. To be honest, there are probably thousands of unreached people within ten minutes of our house. As of now, we meet in our car parking area, but we have a plan to build a very simple structure for gathering on an empty portion of our property.

Thursday evening is our time to pray as a church family. Many are new to Biblical prayer, but some are catching on. Long is a young boy of whom we have written before. One of his church buddies had moved to another location, but no one knew where. Long asked us to pray that he would come back. Within a few weeks of our prayer, he moved back to his old house and is in church again.

SALVATION NEWS

Panya is a young boy who, in the last year, has been increasingly faithful to church. I have talked to him before about salvation but without success. However, in recent weeks, I sensed a change in him. Last Sunday, the two of us sat down, and once again, I shared the good news of salvation with him. He indicated by his answers that he understood his need **and** God's solution, and he asked the Lord to save him.

Theara is an older teen who made a good start by verbally receiving Christ and enthusiastically attending church. But family pressures and behavior issues took over, and Theara dropped out. We visited him a few days ago and found out that he was not crystal clear about the Gospel. After an explanation, we led him to once again put his full trust in a grace salvation. He then opened his heart and shared some personal burdens. With moist eyes, I assured him that he was not alone, and we would pray.
