Dear Praying Friends,

In March, we simply did normal things. We went soul winning, we brought people to church, Angela taught at her Ladies' Meeting, and I prepared for my Burundi trip. But also, we are rejoicing that **our son Caleb got engaged** and will get married in August. My worker Keneeth also got engaged and is gloating that he will get married in July before Caleb does.

Keneeth and I then **spent all of April in Burundi** putting some finishing touches on the radio studio. We had to put a new roof on the new building because the builder just did not do it right. It was leaking and dripped right onto the mixing board, which is still mostly working okay.

Then we finished up the bathroom; we ran pipes and drains, set fixtures, finished tiling the wall, installed a rain-catching system with a 3,000-liter tank, and finished the septic tank. We also built an office downstairs for Pastor Rama.

So now, he can begin having guests on the radio broadcast, and once a month, he will do a Mt. Carmel debate that lasts about four hours. This really, really is listened to and really, really helps people see the truth from the Bible. It reveals how many religious leaders don't follow what is written, and **the eyes of people get opened**.

Then the day we were going to leave, **the voltage regulator died**. We bought a new one, and things still did not work. The Outback system rejected the electricity because the frequency was both too high and too low at the same time! No, I can't explain that, but a supplier found us something that worked. It takes the electricity from 135 volts and kicks it all the way up to 220 volts like it is supposed to be. We also installed some timers I got from the USA; one shuts off the crazy Burundi power during the day so we run fully on solar, and the other shuts down the radio station at night to help conserve the batteries. Complicated, but the radio station is running great now.



I also **preached in the two churches** we work with there and held a health seminar in each. It is my hobby, but I am thrilled I can give some basic natural health advice that has helped many Christians with their ulcers, diabetes, gout, goiters, and so on. Thank you for your prayers and support.
